



Pet Protection Plan

$\frac{4}{12}$ of his money: local rescue group for beagles

$\frac{1}{4}$ of his money: cat and dog toys for the animal shelter

$\frac{2}{8}$ of his money: towels for the animal shelter

$\frac{1}{2}$ of his money: flyers to advertise next month's animal adoption fair

$\frac{8}{12}$ of his money: fabric for making pet blankets for the animal shelter

$\frac{3}{4}$ of his money: office supplies for the animal shelter

$\frac{7}{8}$ of his money: materials for holding a class at school on "Pets and Your Family's Disaster Plan"

$\frac{5}{8}$ of his money: toys to donate to the local animal shelter

$\frac{5}{12}$ of his money: local rescue group for kittens and cats

$\frac{2}{4}$ of his money: cat litter to donate to the local animal shelter

$\frac{1}{2}$ of his money: materials for holding a class at school on "Pets and Your Family's Disaster Plan"

$\frac{3}{4}$ of his money: cat and dog toys for the animal shelter
