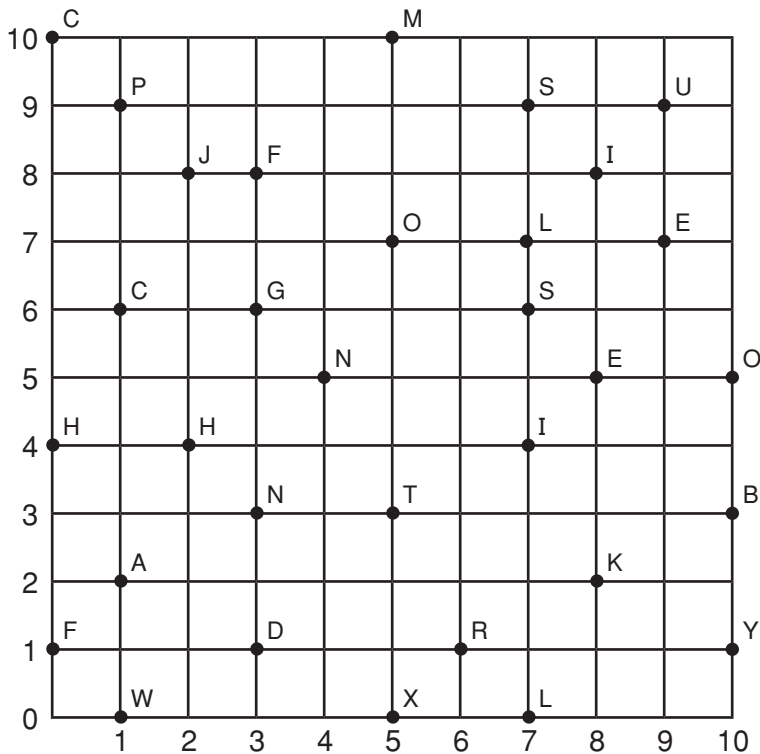


Taking Care of Trees

“Taking Care of Trees”

Answer Key

1. Never POUND NAILS into trees, pull off PIECES OF BARK, or bend and push trees.
2. If a tree is injured by INSECTS, DISEASES, or high WINDS, the tree cuts off CIRCULATION to that part so the problem doesn't spread.
3. Environmental factors affect trees too. POLLUTION can slow growth or even kill trees.
4. A FORESTER manages TREES, SOIL, and WATER to create a habitat for wildlife, plants, and humans.
