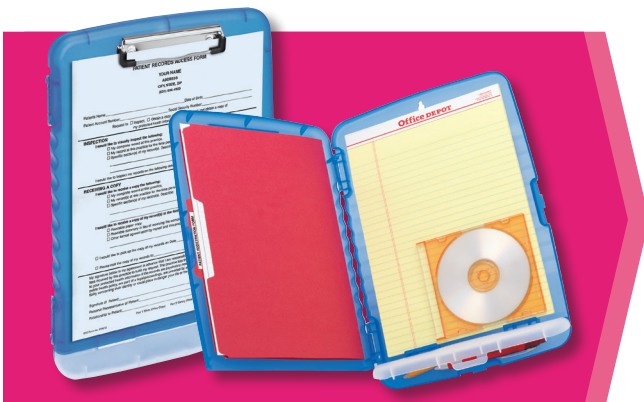


Grab-and-Go Supplies
